Class 6: Junior Showmanship

Open to Juniors between the ages of 7 and 18 years old (inclusive) as of January 1st of current year, showing a draft horse on the line.

The following areas will be considered: Walk, Trot, Turn, Watching Judge, Backing up, Presentation, Suitability of Show Person to Horse, General Handling, Grooming, Decorations, Appointments, General Appearance and Proper Dress, Alertness and Capability. Stallions one year old or over may not be used.

The Junior Showmanship class is part of both the Ontario Percheron and Ontario Clydesdale Associations Showmanship Awards Programs.

Entries taken from 8:00 a.m.

Entry fees:

- Gymkhana Division: \$5.00 per class
- Hunter/Jumper: \$10.00 per class
- Administration fee of \$5.00 per rider.
- Fergus Agricultural Society membership fee of \$6.00 per rider 15 years of age or older as at fair date.
- Refundable number deposit of \$5.00 required.
- Ribbons to 5th place in all divisions.
- Points awarded as follows:
1st – 6, 2nd – 4, 3rd – 3, 4th – 2, 5th – 1
- Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons awarded in all divisions.
- A prize for Best Turnout will be awarded in each of the Gymkhana and Hunter Divisions

Show Rules:

1. All riders must show Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF) membership or proof of insurance.
2. All horse show entrants will be required to complete and sign a Fair Entry Form including a disclaimer.
3. Competitors may enter more than one horse or pony in the divisions, but two competitors may not ride the same horse or pony in any one class.
4. There will be no cross entries. You may enter Ring 1 OR Ring 2 divisions. Riders in Ring 2 (Gymkhana) must be 12 years of age or younger.
5. Classes may be combined or cancelled if there are too few entries.
6. NO refunds after the start of a division. Entries can be made after a division has begun.
7. Hard hats with approved harness and correct riding attire must be worn.
8. Complete English tack to be worn by horses and ponies.
9. No stallions allowed.
10. While every precaution is taken, neither the Fergus Agricultural Society nor Officials are responsible for any loss, damage or injury to property, animals or persons.

6. Prize money will be mailed out after the Fair.
7. Prize ribbons to be given to 5th place with the exception of the Juniors who will receive merit ribbons after 5th place.
8. No refunds once games have begun. If cancellation of an event, refunds will be given out at end of show.
